how?

Making a will ensures that your estate (regardless of size) is divided amongst the people important to you. This can include a charitable cause which is close to your heart and leaving some of your estate to a charity could help to reduce the level of inheritance tax applicable to your estate, which is currently 40% on estates valued at £275,000 or over. (This amount changes annually in accordance with the Governments annual budget announcement).

By remembering the Neuromuscular Centre in your will, people with muscular dystrophy from your region would benefit from vital support. No matter how large or small, a gift in your will can help future generations with this degenerative condition access services which level the playing field of life - In short enabling those affected to live life to its fullest!

A charitable legacy is a tax-free donation which can be made to the Neuromuscular Centre in a number of different ways;

A will or a Codicil (an amendment to a will) is a legal document and we strongly recommend consulting a solicitor.

There are different types of legacies . . .

Residuary Legacy

A gift of the remainder of your estate after all other legacies and bequests to family and friends have been made. The major advantage of a residuary legacy is that its value increases in line with inflation.

Pecuniary Legacy

A gift of a specific sum of money.

Specific Legacy

A gift of a specific item, for example property or a piece of jewellery.
