Qigong Tai Chi

During Spring, our Therapies team launched Tai Chi taster sessions at NMC. Qigong is an ancient system of exercise, originally developed in china over 2,000 years ago. The practice of Qigong involves three key aspects – breath, movement and yi (mind)

Qigong is very effective and easy to learn. The benefits include increased energy, immunity and better balance, though many other improvements are reported for physical and mental well-being.

The gentle movements are suitable for people of all ages and abilities, without putting too much stress on muscles and joints, and can be practiced sitting or standing. It is especially beneficial for people with a neuromuscular condition, as it can improve muscular strength and flexibility, balance and reduce pain and stiffness as well as improving overall fitness and increasing feelings of wellbeing and rejuvenation.

Feedback from these sessions has been extremely positive, with 87% of attendees finding it to be therapeutic and 71% saying they would like a weekly session. Another Tai Chi course will be held throughout the Summer months. If you'd like more information, please contact our Therapies team on 01606 861799.

Bushcraft

NMC has been providing Bushcraft, outdoor cooking and Life skills to over 13s for the past few years. Last year, we worked with Cheshire Outdoors and Cheshire Falconry, who brought beautiful birds of prey to NMC. For this year's series, we are teaming up with Andy Lewis from Wildwood Training.

Our first event of the series took place in April, and was an exciting day of survival which included the construction of a mini woodland shelter and an introduction to the less typical methods of fire lighting.

Bushcraft provides the opportunity to learn new skills and to be challenged – it's so important for our young community to experience what they're capable of. We held the first of a series of events at NMC, in partnership with RJAH Hospital in Oswestry and Hope House. This was aimed at young people with neuromuscular conditions, their families and Carers, to explore topics and issues that affect their lives. A wealth of information was provided to support choices and transition into adult life, with informative talks from Matthew Lanham (NMC's Chief Executive) and Lorraine Woolley (Transitions Officer, who has been involved with NMC right from the beginning). Luke Millington, who comes to NMC for Physiotherapy, discussed learning to drive, Fundraiser Paul Baddeley demonstrated adapted vehicles and there were also sessions on work, volunteering and benefits, as well as practical workshops that included music and bushcraft. The group of 9 young people made beautiful bug houses now on sale at NMC.
